Navigate

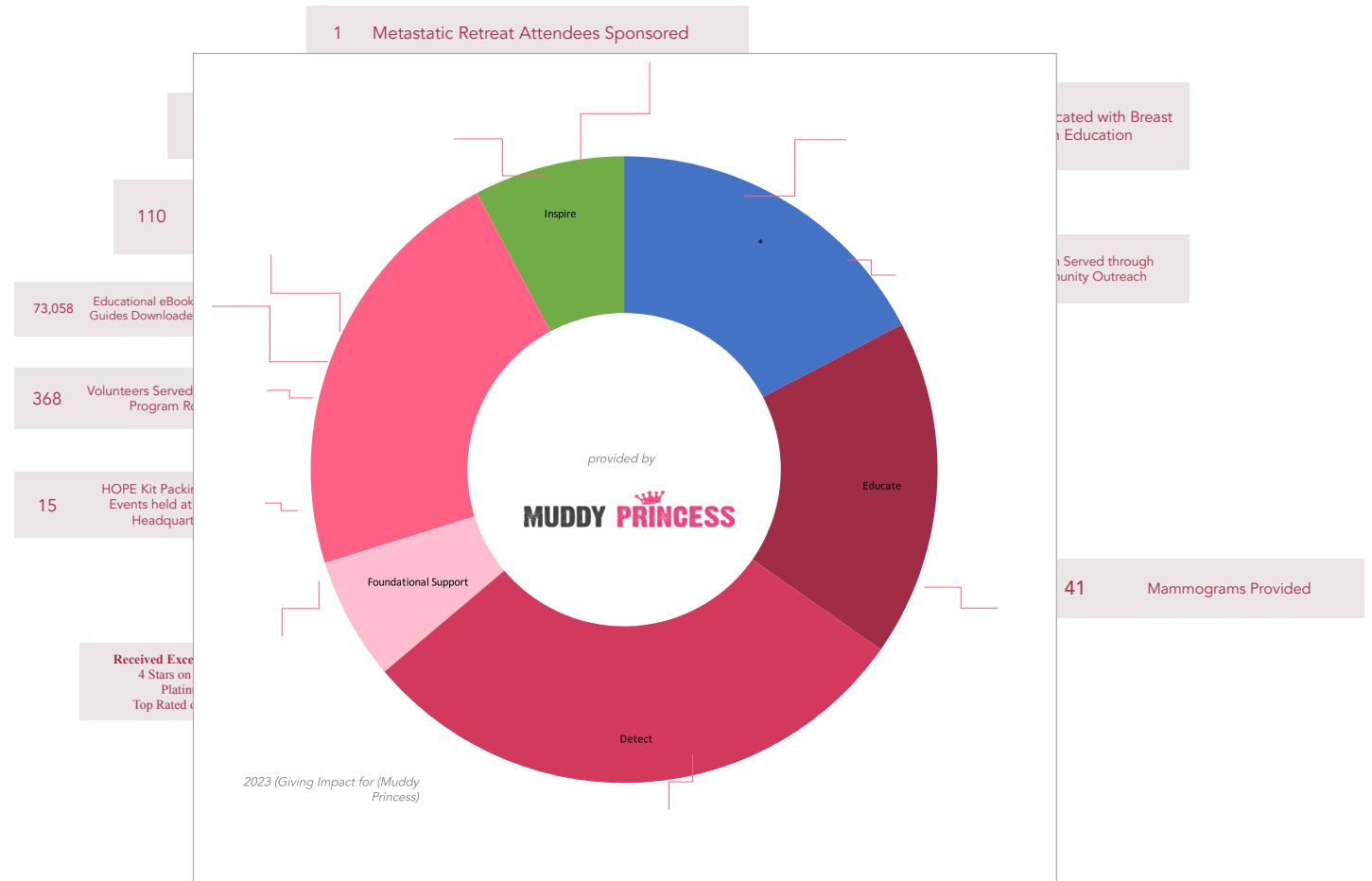
